BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Addison McGuire Duval was born in 1902 in Rhoadesville, Va and received his M.D. in 1929 from the Virginia Commonwealth University. His residency was at Saint Elizabeths Hospital in Washington, D.C. His professional positions included time at the following institutions: 1954-1959 - Assistant Superintendent at Saint Elizabeths; 1959-1962 - Director of State Mental Health in Missouri; and 1963-1972 - Director of State Mental Health in Georgia. Dr. Duval was Treasurer of the American Psychiatric Association from 1959 to 1960, and Vice President from 1962 to 1963 and Speaker of the Assembly of District Branches from 1955 to 1956.

SCOPE AND CONTENTS

These papers of Addison Duval came to the Archives of the American Psychiatric Association from Dr. Duval in 1982. The collection totals .25 linear feet and consists of 2 series: articles and papers and miscellaneous. The articles and papers are his published and unpublished works between 1952 and 1975. Dr. Duval's correspondence and other papers remain in his possession currently. Duval's papers are filed in the same box as the papers of Jacob Dunton.
